

## Travel to Women's College within The University of Queensland

(The College is circled in Red on the Map below)

### By Car

From Brisbane's CBD, Sir Fred Schonell Drive is most easily accessed via Coronation Drive. Continue over 2 roundabouts, drive along Campbell Road, left into Blair Drive, right into Sir William Macgregor Drive, right into Thynne Road, left into College Road.

### By Ferry

The CityCat's new terminus is only 150 metres from the College.

### By Bus

29 starts at Woolloongabba

66 from bus stations at Royal Brisbane Hospital, QUT Kelvin Grove, Normandy, Roma Street, King George Square, Cultural Centre, Princess Alexandra Hospital, CBD's King George Square, Mater Hill, Boggo Road, Dutton Park to the UQ Lakes Bus Station.

139 from Calamvale to the UQ Lakes Bus Station.

169 from Eight Mile Plains busway station to the UQ Lakes Bus Station.

209 from Carindale Interchange to the UQ Lakes bus Station.

There is then a 200m walk to the College.

### By Train

Take the train to the Park Road station on the Airport/Beenleigh/Ferny Grove line, transfer to the Boggo Road Bus Station and catch any of the buses (66, 139, 169, 209) going to UQ Lakes. They will go over the Eleanor Schonell Bridge.
